RE: Year 11 Parents' Evening Questionnaire Feedback

Last term we trialled an electronic questionnaire at parents' evening for the first time and the information that we received was really informative to us. I'd like to take this opportunity to say thank you for your feedback and inform you of the responses that were made as a year group. This analysis is based on 51 responses on the evening:

Q1. My child is happy at this school	96% agree and above
Q2. My child feels safe at school	96% agree and above
Q3. My child is making good progress at the school	98% agree and above
Q4. My child is well looked after at the school	98% agree and above
Q5. My child is taught well at the school	98% agree and above
Q6. The school ensures the students are well behaved	94% agree and above
Q7. The school deals effectively with bullying	82% agree and above
Q8. The school is well led and managed	100% agree and above
Q9. The school responds well to any concern that I raise	92% agree and above
Q10. I receive valuable information from the school about my child's progress	98% agree and above
Q11. I would recommend this school to another parent	96% agree and above
Q12. I am aware of my child's predicted grades.	100% agree and above

We are also grateful to those parents who gave us further details of their concerns if they felt they 'disagreed' or 'strongly disagreed' with a statement. Although this was only a small minority of responses, we do take your feedback seriously and would like to take this opportunity to reassure you of what is already in place or what we plan to do in response to any concerns raised.

First and foremost, let me reassure you that we approach '**bullying**' with priority. We urge students to inform us of any incidents that might take place immediately so that we can take the appropriate action.

However, we do plan on doing some further work about the definition of 'bullying' itself. It is important that our whole community understands what this very emotive term actually means at the Nottingham Girls' Academy. This will be discussed in assemblies, tutor time and in communications home. Our aim is that bullying remains extremely rare at the Nottingham Girls' Academy and that each and every child feels like we deal with any incidents of it quickly and effectively.

Furthermore, we are doing a lot of work on being kind and committing Random Acts of Kindness (RAK) and we would encourage you to emphasise this at home too.

We can assure you that the **heating** is on during the winter periods; if there is ever a time where your child is too cold, please advise them to communicate this to staff at the time.

We are currently working with the Student Council about the different menu options available during break and lunch time but we can confirm that the chicken we serve is **halal**.
