<p>Re-sequence their curriculum where they have identified it is required.</p> <p>Complete short-term planning to support the delivery of the amended curriculum in September.</p>	<p>KS3: No resequencing – but an awareness that during Unit 1 Yr8 (Living World), more time may be needed to ensure pupils understand atmospheric circulation (rising falling air cells) that is covered in W&C Yr7.</p> <p>KS4: Yr11- Plan to start with Economic world overview (go over what has already been set for home learning) to allow students to either complete work they haven't done during lockdown OR provide additional exam practice questions to those who have completed work (and are confident with it). The proposal of Ofqual to NOT do fieldwork in 2021 exam Paper3, will allow us to focus solely on content for Paper1 & Paper2 and spend this time revisiting the content set during this summer term.</p> <p>Yr10 – we delayed the start of the new unit (Urban Issues) during last weeks of July so we could start fresh. This puts us a third of a unit (plus no physical geog fieldwork) behind our Long range S.o.W. Until the trust allows us to complete fieldwork – we can not plan for this. There is a time buffer allowance at the end of Yr11 (for revision) to allow for the delay in Yr9/10.</p> <p>KS5: Summer packs of work will be distributed to students by post the week beginning 20.07.20. This is to continue exam practice (essay writing and knowledge recall).</p>	<p>KS3: No resequencing – but an awareness that during Unit 1 Yr8 (Elizabeth/Spanish Armada), more time may be needed to ensure pupils understand the split in the church and the impact that had on the monarchy and England (usually covered during end of Yr7).</p> <p>KS4: Yr11 – Conflict and Tension Unit was studied during Lockdown – ERI to re go over this content as under Ofqual's proposed exam revisions, THIS will be the compulsory unit. This means we may not have to cover the final unit (Germany) – only 3 units will be examined, which for us could be Medicine, Elizabeth (already studied in Yr9/10 prior to lockdown) and Conflict and Tension.</p> <p>Yr10 – Decision to re go over the Industrial Revolution (third part) of the Medicine unit that was set during lockdown and then complete the unit, as understanding of concepts during this time period are crucial for understanding the fourth part. There is a time buffer allowance at the end of Yr11 (for revision) to allow for the delay in Yr9/10.</p> <p>KS5: NEA was delayed (should have been launched after Easter 2020) - instead more content for Paper1&2 was set, as this chronologically builds on content already studied. In September the NEA will be launched and then the content for Paper1&2 will be returned to.</p>
<p>Prepare assessment materials to support the delivery of the curriculum in</p>	<p>Retrieval activities (yr8 and yr9) in the first term are directly linked to previous year's content.</p> <p>Geography KS3 - KOs have been created for all units – students will receive a <u>hard copy</u> of the KOs for their year group for the 2020/21 academic year in booklet form (along with copies of their Learning Journey, key terminology, PLCS and retrieval activities) and will also have</p>

We can then assess in October where priorities for further consolidation may be.</p>
