No changes needed for Y10 and Y12 – new groups and new qualification.

Y11: Rather than completing part of Component 2 and the entirety of Component 3, only Component 3 will need to be completed as Component 2 was banked along with Component 1 as CAGs. This means that more time is available rather than less, however Component 3 would have been started this year to give students the opportunity to have two chances at the exam (January and June). This will still happen, but the content won't have been fully covered by the time of the January exam.

Y13: No resits will be needed (hopefully) for the CAG entered grades (Units 3 and 6), so this frees up time in the last term, and there may be additional time as well. There are normally four units completed in Y13 anyway, so there will be little difference except for the order the units are completed in.

KS3 will be running a new curriculum, so it will just be a distilled version of what it should be in Y7 and Y8. Y9 won't have had some of the underlying knowledge, so this has been totally re-sequenced (which would have needed to happen anyway due to moving to the new curriculum. By reducing the content in the first four half-terms, it should mean that the last term will not need to be changed as long as nothing more happens with Covid19. All 'hands-on' units will have that aspect removed (e.g. building a robot, creating an app).

Y13 – Unit 17 has been started this term, albeit progress has inevitably been slower than normal. However, we usually have time to spare so it will mean that extra time can be used to still finish on time. No re-sequencing is needed. It is also anticipated that the deadline for coursework will be extended, which means that there will be no problems finishing all work on time. Also, there is usually some time spent working on resits for the exams. These were banked as CAGs so will most likely not be needed unless the exam board disagrees with the grades.
