Talent 1st are delighted to have the opportunity to hold an actor workshop with all year 7 8's and 9's next week at Nottingham Girls Academy.

The workshop will last just under 1 hour. Everyone will have an opportunity to take part. We do not require participants to have previous experience in performance of any kind. We are interested in every individual and their own unique personality and energy.

The workshop will be improvisation group based and very relaxed and informal. We just ask pupils join in, have fun and be themselves!

From the first round of workshops, Talent 1st will shortlist a number of students from each year group to invite back on Friday for 1 hour to participate in another workshop.
