
## **Re: Electric Scooters as transport to school**

In recent weeks, we have seen an increase in the number of pupils who are using electric scooters to travel to and from school, often not wearing the appropriate safety equipment. Whilst legal to use on private land, electric scooters are illegal to use in public unless part of a recognised local transport scheme, such as that run by Nottingham City Council. Electric scooters are classed as powered transporters and, therefore, are subject to the same laws as cars and other motor vehicles, including tax, MOT, licensing, and specific construction, and cannot be driven on pavements, footpaths or other pedestrianised areas.

If a pupil arrives at school on an electric scooter, parents will be informed and the scooter will be confiscated until a parent or other appropriate adult can collect it.

We appreciate your support in keeping pupils safe in their travel to and from Nottingham Girls' Academy.
