Dear Parent or Carer

Free School Meals

I am writing to inform you that students who meet certain criteria are eligible for free school meals. Where students are eligible, they will receive a daily meal deal of a hot meal or sandwich and desert at lunch time. Students eligible for free school meals at Nottingham Girls' Academy are offered a breakfast before the start of the school day as well. In order to access free school meals, parents or carers must apply by completing the following form on the Nottingham City Council website, this can be accessed by clicking the link on this page. The following criteria will help you decide if you might be eligible to apply:

Eligibility

My child(ren):

- Is aged 16 or under
- Attends a Nottingham city school

If you, the parent or carer, receive at least one of the following benefits:

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseekers Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- the guarantee element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit, but NOT entitled to Working Tax Credit and you have an annual gross income
 of no more than £16,190, as assessed by Her Majesty's Revenue and Customs.
- Support under of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999, section 95
- Universal Credit (income thresholds apply)

*Where a parent is entitled to Working Tax Credit Run-on - the payment someone receives for a further four weeks after they stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit - their children are entitled to free school lunches. Children who receive a qualifying benefit in their own right are also eligible to receive free school meals.

You may also be eligible if your child(ren):

- is/are 19 or under
- attends the sixth form at a Nottingham City LEA maintained school, full-time
